








Revenue Trend (Business Domain)


1. Continuous growth of our business. Revenue in FY06 → US\$3.67 Billion


Yokogawa Sales Trend Outside Japan

Registrations and applications for patents and other intellectual property rights (as of March 31, 2006)








>YEI Sales Trend



D company continues to struggle.






Our growth outside of Japan
