To explain the functionality of the Consolidated Alarm Management Software for HIS (CAMS for HIS) in normal operation (run-time) this training is made. After completion of the training participants will be able to

- Explain the difference between CAMS and CAMS for HIS
- Recall and use the different type of lists on the operator station
- Interpret the different area in the CAMS monitor
- Use the primary CAMS functions (filtering, sorting, shelving, eclipsing and load shedding)
- Modify the CAMS for HIS monitor layout in real-time (if security allows this)
- Create static and dynamic filters
